

## CONFIRMATION SAINT PAMPHLET – 2021-2022 GUIDELINES

In preparing to receive the sacrament of Confirmation you are preparing for the Holy Spirit to give you gifts that will allow you to practice your Catholic faith in all aspects of your lives. During this time it is customary to choose a Confirmation name ***based on the name of a Catholic Saint*** to serve as your Confirmation saint who will serve to inspire you and guide you in living a holy life.

- Use **color** and **images** to enhance your pamphlet

\*\*Saints with minimal biographical information: elaborate on the *social/political conditions of the world, empire, or country in which they lived*
